1 Version [2.7.0] – Emphasis on API V1 to API V2

Plattform Release 1.14:

- On TRAIN: 26.01.26
- On PROD: 19.02.26

1.1 Breaking Changes

API v2 introduces a major architectural refactoring of the public API.

The changes are **not backward compatible** with API v1.

Key breaking changes include:

- Introduction of new transmission aggregates with clear separation by use case
- New endpoint structure under `/api/document-exchange/v2`
- New DTOs and lifecycle models
- No 1:1 mapping of API v1 endpoints to API v2

API v1 and API v2 can be operated **in parallel**

Repurposing of Submission and Transfer

As part of the technical transmission split introduced with API v2, the former transmission concepts from API v1 have been restructured and mapped to new, more explicit transmission types.

Former Transmission type	New Technical Type	New Business Type	Remarks
Submission	AttachmentTransmission	Submission	Same purpose as the former Submission(Submission)
Submission	AttachmentTransmission	Delivery	Same purpose as the former Submission(Delivery)
Transfer	SharingTransmission	Delivery	Same purpose as the former Transfer
Transfer	SharingTransmission	Consultation of Files	Similar to the former Transfer, but without automated 7 days reception

1.2 Migration Notes

- API v1 and API v2 are available in parallel
- Migration is recommended use-case-based, not endpoint-based
- New integrations should use API v2
- Existing integrations may remain on API v1 and migrate incrementally

1.3 Added

- `SharingTransmission` for document sharing use cases
- `AttachmentTransmission` for submissions and deliveries
- Support for forwarding submissions via explicit references
- Enhanced support for decentral document references
- Clearer separation of responsibilities between sender, receiver, and owner roles
- Permissive variants of ToC and chunked document upload endpoints for Qualified Profiles

1.4 Changed

- Clearer and more consistent transmission lifecycle models
- Improved error handling semantics (`400`, `403`, `409`, `422`)
- More explicit domain-driven API structure
- Improved validation and consistency across DTOs
- Better suitability for future functional extensions

1.5 Deprecated

- API v1 is deprecated for functional extensions
- Only security fixes and critical bug fixes will be applied
- Revocation of deliveries and file consultations is no longer supported.

Planned end of support for API v1: 31.05.26

1.6 Removed

- No silent removals
- All functional replacements are introduced via API v2

1.7 Security

- Bearer token authentication (JWT) remains unchanged
- JWKS endpoint remains available
- No security-related breaking changes introduced in API v2
