Decomission of API V1 & recent changes



Last day of operation API v1

31. Mai 2026

From this date onwards, the endpoints of API v1 will no longer be available.

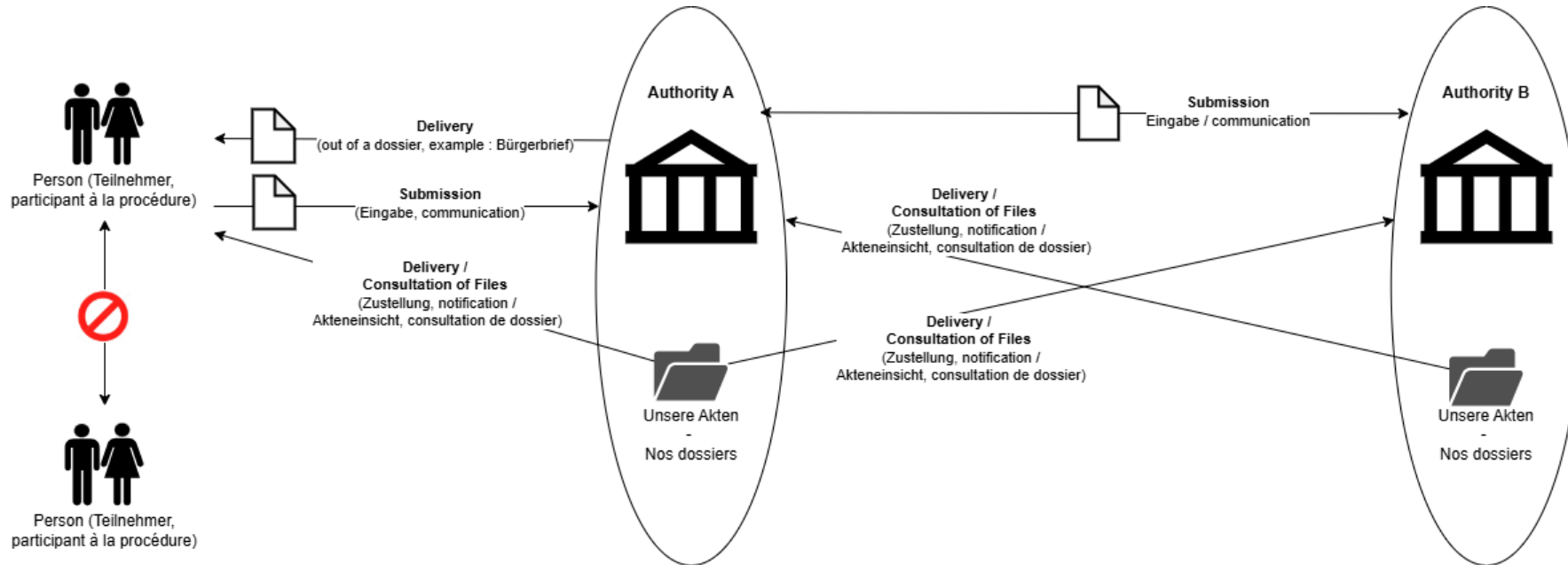
Important

API v2 is not backward compatible with v1. Therefore needed adjustments should be done and switched to the new V2 by the time of the decomissioning.

Decomission of API V1 - Breaking Changes

New transmission aggregates with clear separation by use case:

Former Transmission type	New Technical Type	New Business Type	Remarks
Submission	AttachmentTransmission	Submission	Same purpose as the former Submission(Submission)
Submission	AttachmentTransmission	Delivery	Same purpose as the former Submission(Delivery)
Transfer	SharingTransmission	Delivery	Same purpose as the former Transfer
Transfer	SharingTransmission	Consultation of Files	Similar to the former Transfer, but without automated 7 days reception



AttachmentTransmission : no link to any dossier (Eingabe, communication)



businessType: SUBMISSION (Eingabe, communication), DELIVERY (very rare case for Bürgerbrief for example, Zustellung ausserhalb von einer Akte, notification hors d'une procédure existante).



SharingTransmission : always from an existing dossier on the platform

businessType: CONSULTATION_OF_FILES (Akteneinsicht, droit de consultation d'un dossier), DELIVERY (Zustellung, notification)

- New endpoint-structure under /v2
- New DTOs
- No 1:1 mapping for V1 to V2 endpoints

- **Added: Forwarding Submissions**

Efficient forwarding of submission between authorities without data loss are now possible

- **How it works:**

Creation via `POST /attachment-transmissions`. Reference the original ID via `refToOriginalSubmission`

- **Benefits for the implementation:**

Full traceability in the `forwardingInfo` object and automatic status update for the original submission (`hasBeenForwarded`)

- **Restriction:**

Only one forwarding per original submission is allowed

- **Added: Signature and seal validation**

The validity of Seals from authorities can now be checked

- **How it works:**

- Trigger check via `POST /api/document-exchange/v2/dossiers/{dossier-id}/documents/{document-id}/validation`
- The extension of `DocumentPublicDto` with the `validation` field and new DTO's `DocumentValidationPublicDto` and `SignaturePublicDto` contains the validation status (`VALID`, `INVALID`, `UNSURE`, etc.) and all relevant details about the signatures

- **Deprecated: Revoke**

The callback function (revoke) is no longer available: Due to the lack of a regulatory framework and insufficient procedural traceability (no acknowledgments), the function has been completely removed.

- **How it works:**

Trying to set the status to REVOKED via PUT /transmission-id/status will now return an error message. Status REVOKED in the DTO is still in place for Permission Changes on the Dossier.

- **Changed: Optimistic Concurrency Control (Versioning)**

The handling of concurrency has been changed for Transmissions. To enable 'lightweight' concurrent changes, the version fields are now ignored during updates

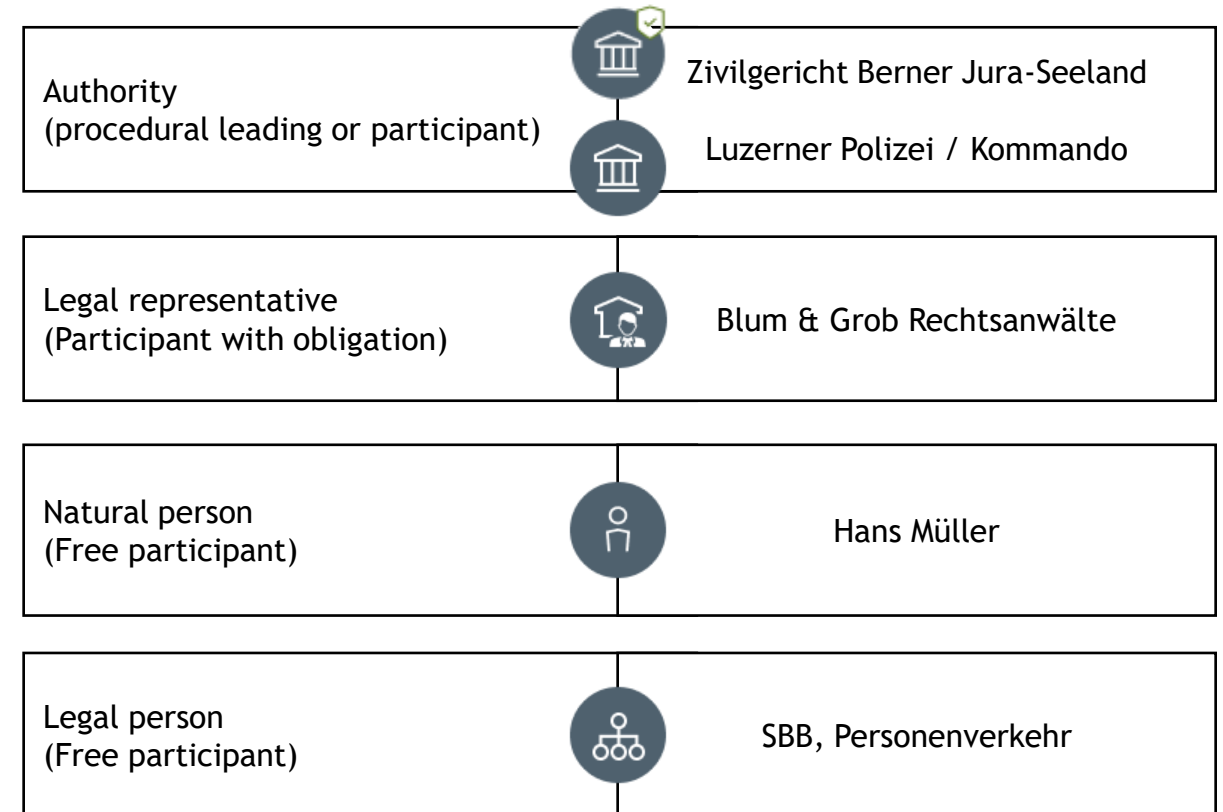
- Note: This lightweight form is only applicable for pure content updates (Metadata e.g. `UpdateSharingTransmissionDto`) or for linking documents (e.g. `LinkDocumentDto`). It is still a strict validation for state changes (e.g. status in `UpdateSharingTransmissionStatusDto`)
- In this context the `version` fields in the following DTO's are marked as deprecate: `UpdateSharingTransmissionDto`, `UpdateAttachmentTransmissionRequestDto`, `LinkDocumentDto`

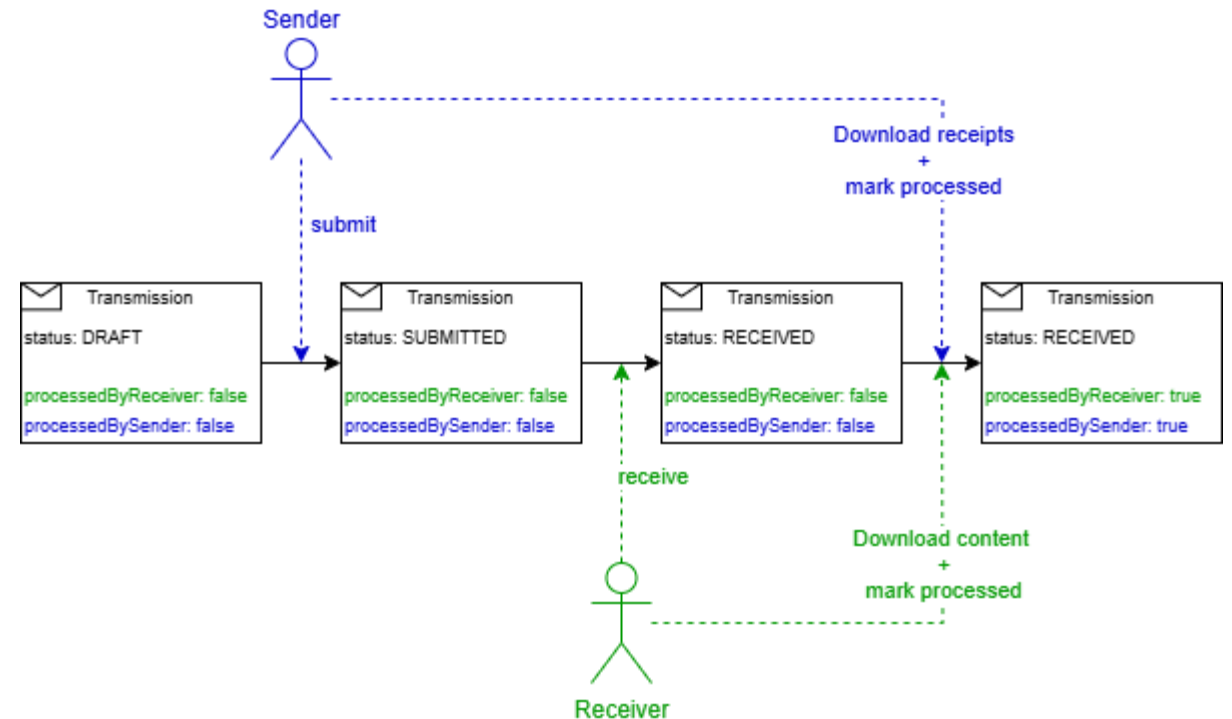
• New Profiles

- End of private profiles & new types:
- Additional attributes for distinguishing & searching lawyers
- Indicate in which procedures you want to communicate electronically (Civil-, criminal-, administrative law...)



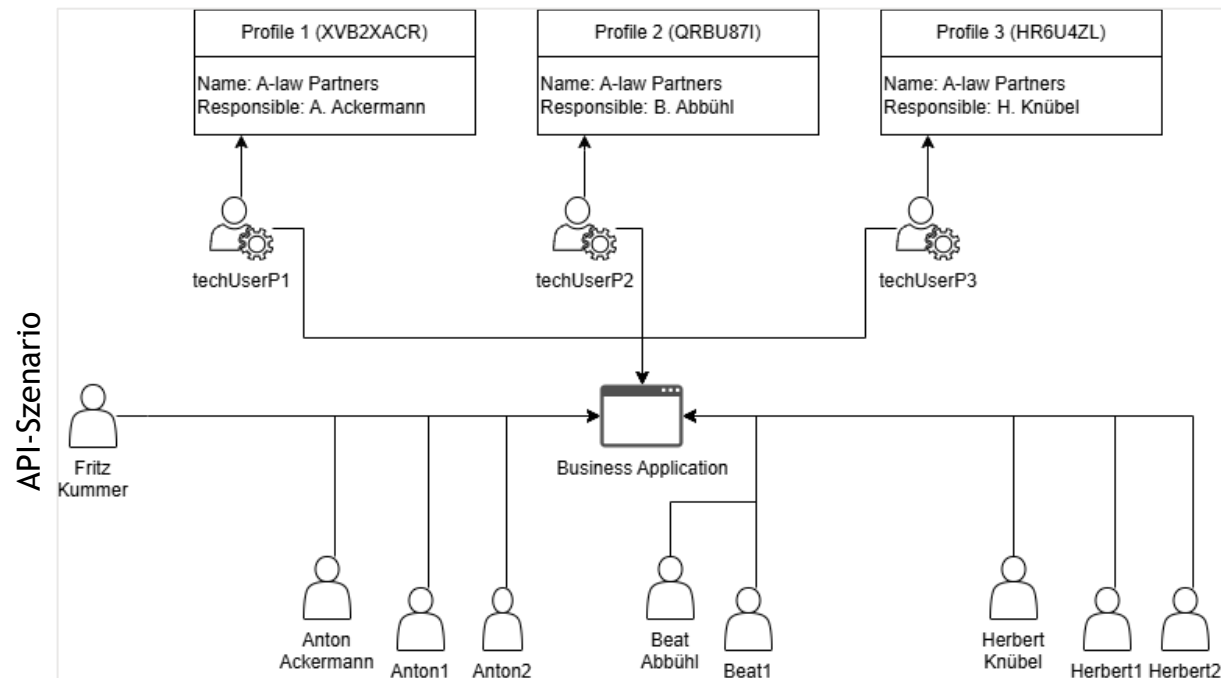
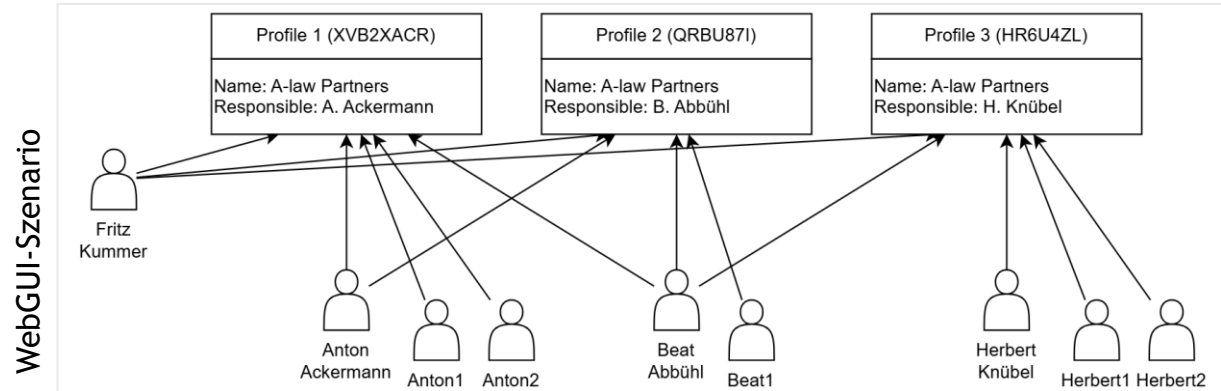
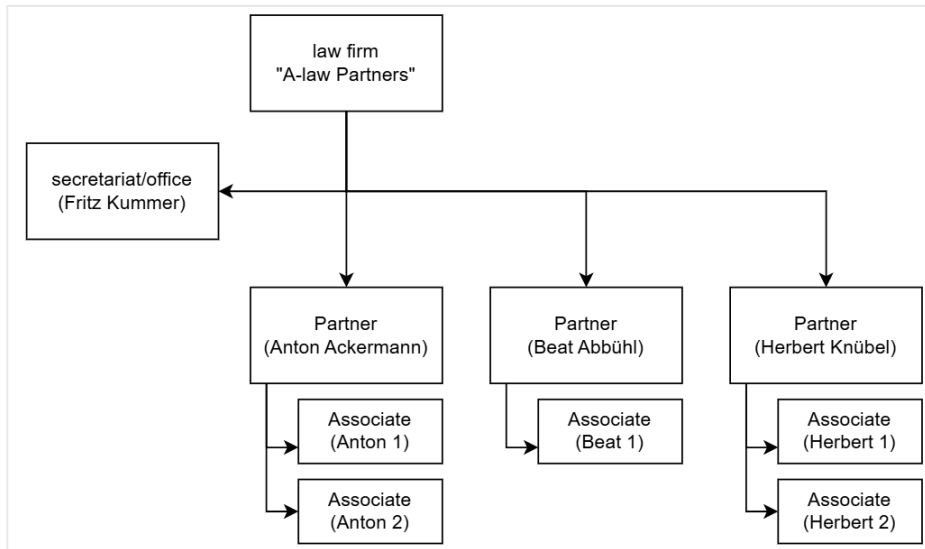
• Processed flag via API

- When polling transmission via API
→ the in- and outbox can be filtered by processed flags and thus enhance the processing-logic
- Receiver-side (Inbox): can set a processedByReceiver flag after setting the transmission to RECEIVED and downloading the content.
- Sender-side (Outbox): can set a processedBySender flag after the transmissions was RECEIVED (by receiver) and downloaded the receipts.

Example hierarchy:

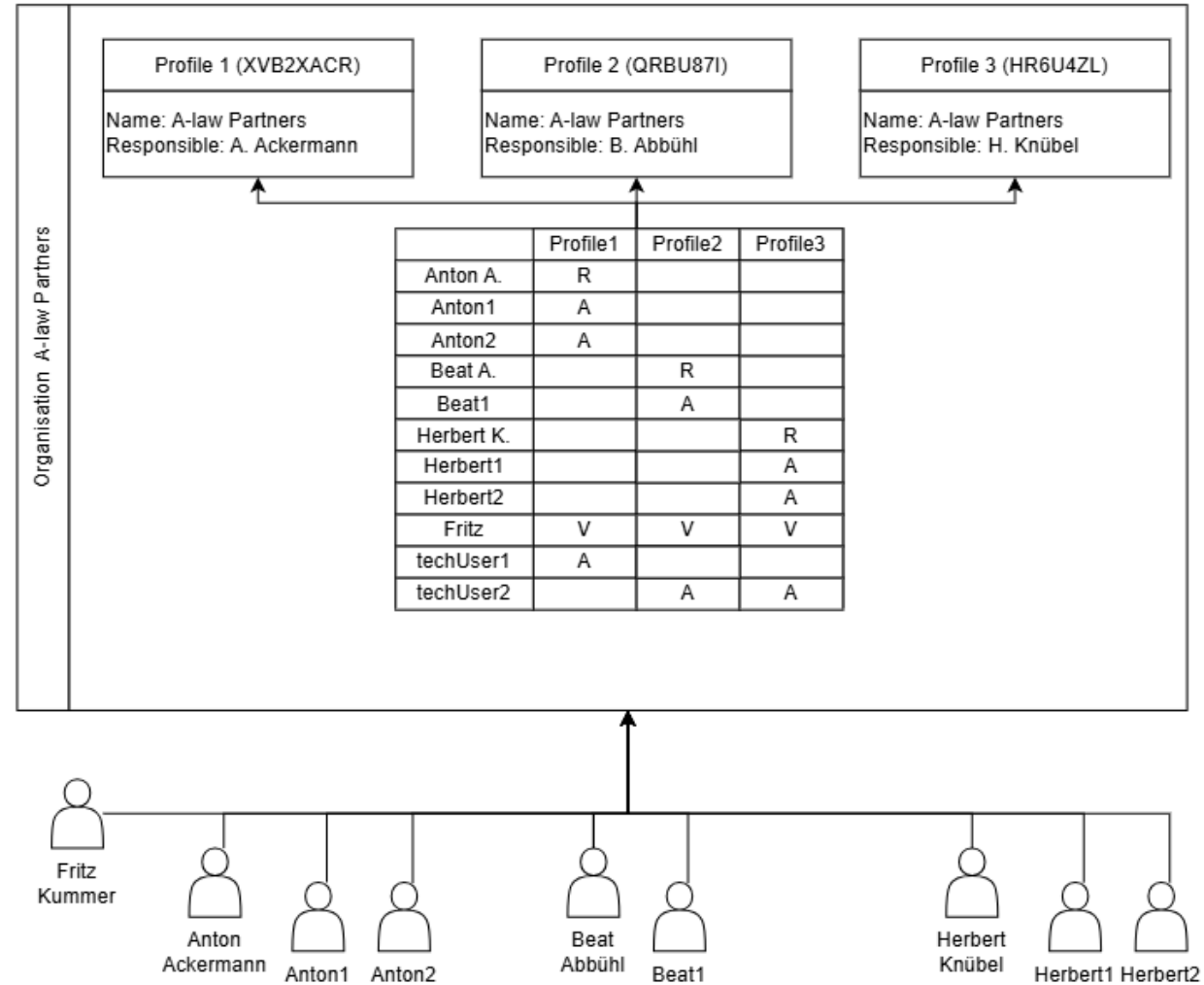


- Profile organization

This will allow to facilitate the access management easier on business application side.



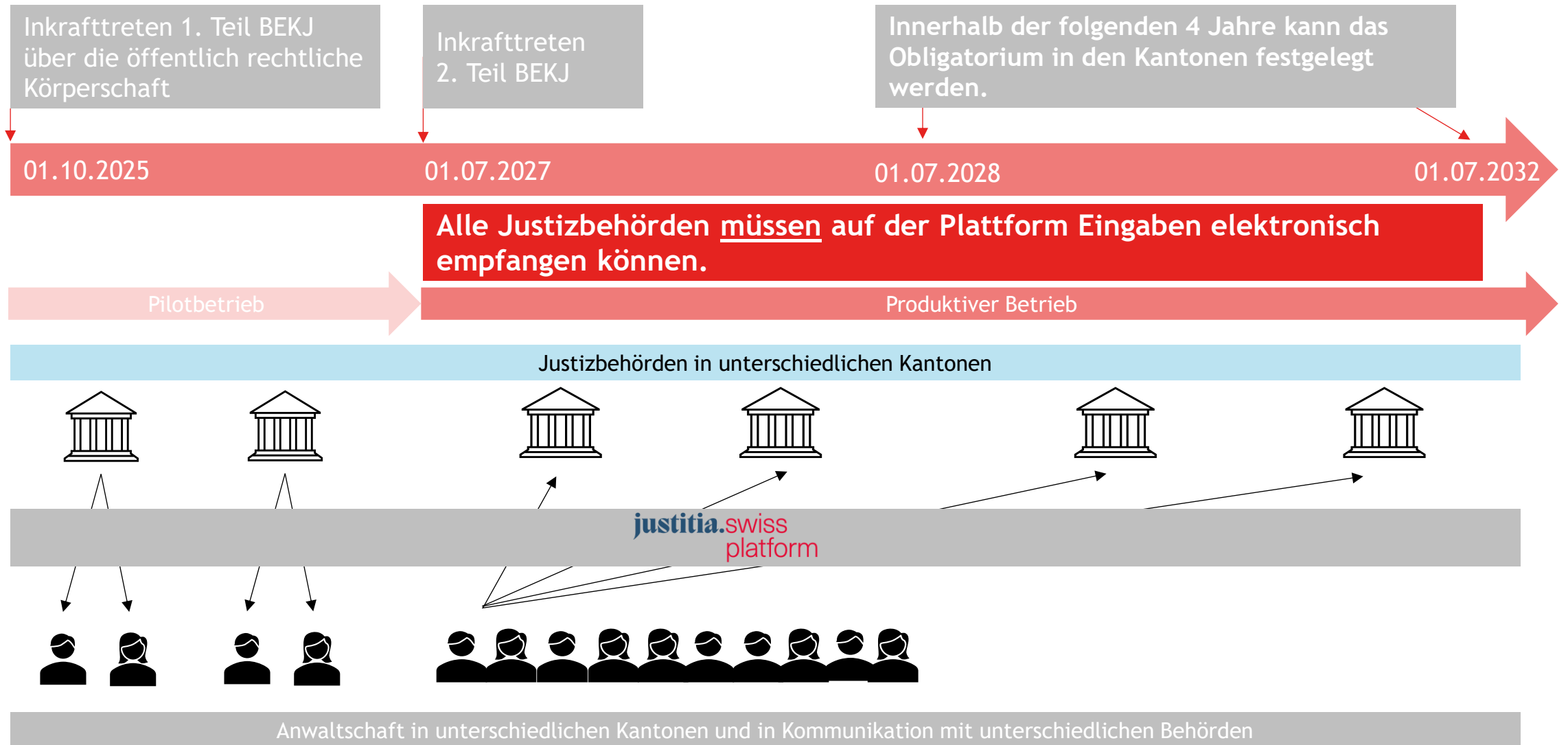
